WASHINGTON, DC – The Eisenhower Memorial Commission today released the voting results of the two resolutions introduced at the September 17th commission meeting:

RESOLUTION #1, introduced by Commissioner Geduldig:

The Commission authorizes the presentation of both the Revised Design* and the concept of the Alternative Design** to the National Capital Planning Commission on October 2, 2014 for review.

The resolution was defeated by a vote of 8 to 2, and one abstention.

The result of this vote: Only the Revised Design presented at the NCPC information session on September 4th will be presented for Preliminary Approval at the NCPC meeting scheduled for October 2, 2014.

RESOLUTION #2, introduced by Commissioner Cole:

That the Commission pause until 1st November 2014, for a period of stocktaking, planning, and reflections before the remaining appropriated dollars are spent down and the worst possible scenario occurs: the Commission runs out of money and no memorial to Eisenhower ever gets built. During the pause the Commission directs the staff to expend funds limited only to payroll, rent, utilities and other fixed costs associated with the essential daily operations of the Commission. And during that time we return to the NCPC, as mandated by the Issa amendment for an information session only and not for a vote for approval.

The resolution was defeated by a vote of 8 to 2, and one abstention.



The result of this vote: Only the Revised Design presented at the NCPC information session on September 4th will be presented for Preliminary Approval at the NCPC meeting scheduled for October 2, 2014.
